BSFG Action Groups

Bulk Food Co-operative: enables members to buy mainly Australian produced non-perishable foods without packaging.

Renewable Energy Benalla: explores renewable energy options for Benalla and pursues community energy projects. www.reb.org.au

Sustainable Building: considers issues relating to sustainable housing design and retrofitting for energy efficiency.

Plastic Wise Benalla: works with the community, local businesses and Council towards Benalla becoming a plastic bag free town.

Benalla Local Food Network: encourages local food growers, retailers, organisations and community members to come together to supply the town with healthy food.

Web Team: maintains the BSFG website and social media accounts, informing and updating the community about sustainability issues.
